Rules & Regulations

- An entry form must be submitted by 18:00 on the 1st of October 2022. No late entries will be accepted
- The league will start on the weekend of the 8th of October with the games to be played throughout the term on Saturdays or Sundays.
- Matches will be played on the grass pitches and STP (synthetic turf pitch) across the weekend.
- All Matches will last 90 minutes with 10 minutes allocated for half time.
- If a match needs to be re-arranged, it will be done so at the earliest opportunity subject to pitch availability and agreement from both teams.
- Matches will be self-officiated via an allocated member of a league team.
- Teams will be required to collect, nets, flags, and bibs from the sportspark reception before the games
- Failure to provide a referee when you have been allocated a fixture to be officiated will result in a 3-point deduction.
- Teams will need to provide their own linesman.
- Fixtures, results, and league tables will be displayed on <http://full-time.thefa.com/>
- There will be a knockout stage for qualifying teams
- All players will be required to wear shin pads.
- All players should wear suitable footwear.
- The captain of both teams will be required to submit a post-match score via email by 12:00pm Monday. If by that time, a captain fails to provide a post-match score and the opposition has, that score will be considered correct. If neither captain provides a post-match form, that fixture will be void
- The captain from each team will also be required to give a list of goal scorer's names. (There will be a Golden boot award for the top league goal scorer)
- The minimum period of notice to inform the league that you are unable to field a side is 48hrs from the day of the fixture. Anything less than this the game will be awarded to the opposing team as a walkover and a 3-0 score-line.
- If the league is notified within the 48hrs then the league coordinator will offer all available times for the game to be rearranged. If an appropriate time to rearrange the fixture cannot be found, the team that originally cancelled will lose a point.
- All teams need to ensure that they leave the playing fields clean and tidy, free from empty drinks bottles and other types of litter as bins are provided.
- All decisions made by the league co-ordinator are final.

- Please note that games will be filmed for both security and promotional reasons.
